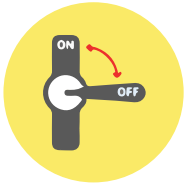

What to do if you suspect a gas leak?



Turn off the
main gas valve
inside meter
cabinet



Open doors
and windows



Avoid all sources
of ignition and
naked flames



Step outside the
premises then
call 800-5224
(800 LBCG)

How to prevent gas leak / gas emergency?



Never leave cooking food unattended.



Ensure the gas switch is turned "ON" and gas detector indicates green lit (no alarm) before operating any gas equipment.



Turn off the gas switch when not in use.



Ensure gas equipment switch knob is in fully turned off position before and after use.



Do not block the gas detectors and the gas system components.



Keep the oven door open when switching it on.



Allow the gas system to be regularly checked by authorized Gas Technicians.



Minimize movement of cooking equipment during cleaning to prevent loose fittings.



Do not store items in the gas meter cabinet.



Ensure anti-strain cable is installed to prevent excessive strain on gas hose and its fittings when equipment is moved.

Hissing /
whistling sound
